

HELPING COMMUTERS

Conservatives are committed to helping hardworking commuters in Haywards Heath:

- Fuel duty has been frozen until 2015 saving the average motorist £11 every time they fill the tank. Petrol is now 20p a litre cheaper then under Labour's plans. Conservatives in Haywards Heath are campaigning for fuel companies to give fairer prices to local motorists.
- Rail fare rises have been capped at no more than the rate of inflation in 2014.
- The Government has committed to a further £50million for a full redevelopment of the railway station at Gatwick Airport.
- £77million improvmenets to the A23 at Handcross are due to be completed next year.
- A Network Rail study into the Brighton Mainline, including a Lewes-Uckfield connection to create a second mainline is being accelerated.

There is the possibility of a project to not just address traffic calming, but to carry out significant works to improve the appearance of the parade, possibly creating a village-like environment.
